

Usage of local terminals ... in 10 minutes and on 1 slide!

- Login with the 'trcray?' UID and the **System password** given in the letter addressed to you.
- From the 'Chameleon' (down left corner) open a Terminal (Konsole). From this terminal you can run '**ssh -X cca**' to access the Cray HPCF.
 - Editors available on cca are '**vi**', '**gvim**', '**gedit**', '**xedit**', '**emacs**'.
- The classroom printer (ps_classroom) is available from your desktop or cca:
'lpr -Pps_classroom <filename>'
- Start Firefox. Go to 'www.ecmwf.int'. Login with your 'trcray?' UID and the **Web password** shown on the letter. Let Firefox remember this password. Then go to 'software.ecmwf.int' and search for 'hpcf'. Select the "hpcf" training page. [This is the 'home' page for this course.](#)
- You can start '**~trx/view_slides**' or '**~trx/view_demo**' (on your PC) to follow on your desktop screen what is shown on the white screen.
- Before leaving in the evening, remember to **lock** your login session, to exit '**qsub -l**' sessions on cca and possibly to check for zombie jobs.
