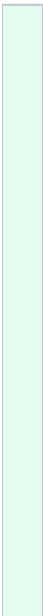

The TIGGE dataset consists of ensemble forecast data from thirteen global NWP centres, starting from October 2006. TIGGE was established as a key component of [THORPEX](#): a World Weather Research Programme to accelerate the improvements in the accuracy of 1-day to 2 week high-impact weather forecasts for the benefit of humanity. Although the 10-year THORPEX program ended at the end of 2014, TIGGE has continued and the next five-year phase of the archive (2024–2028) is currently underway.

While TIGGE data is available free of charge, **TIGGE users are strongly encouraged to publicise all of their research articles and applications** that use any aspect of TIGGE data by emailing ECMWF's [service desk](#) with a link to the article.
